Hawaii Gets Hit Hard

Hawaii's weather in 2026 has been dominated by unusually heavy rainfall and storm activity, making it one of the wettest starts to a year in recent memory. A series of powerful winter storm systems—known as Kona lows—have brought repeated rounds of torrential rain, flooding, and severe weather across the islands.

From February through March, rainfall totals have been well above average, with some locations seeing months' worth of rain in just days. In Honolulu, early-season rainfall reached levels not seen in over 20 years, while parts of Maui and Oahu recorded 20–40+ inches during major storm events.

These conditions led to widespread flooding, infrastructure damage, and a federal disaster declaration, with total damages estimated at over \$1 billion.

Even into April, the pattern has continued, with additional storms, saturated ground, and ongoing flood risks as new systems bring more heavy rain to the islands.

Despite the stormy pattern, temperatures have remained fairly typical for Hawaii—generally warm and stable, with highs in the upper 70s to low 80s—highlighting that this year's story is less about temperature and more about extreme precipitation and volatility.

Bottom line: 2026 has brought a significantly wetter and more volatile-than-normal start to the year in Hawaii, with ongoing impacts from repeated heavy rain events.
